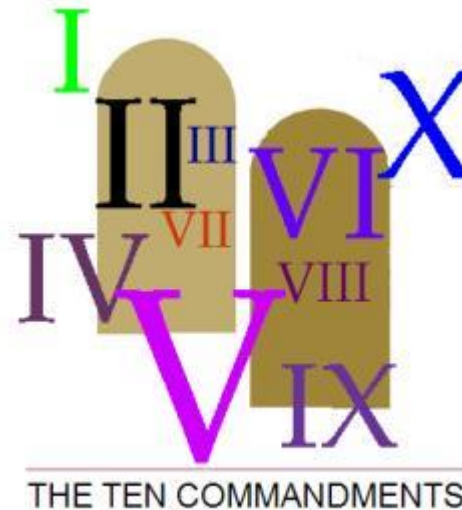
**Witness Bibles:** Lead others to Christ using a Bible tabbed especially for that purpose. These Bibles are available in the Welcome Center.
